


While the saying **as American**



An Orchard Journey: From Seed to Harvest

Apples are part of the rose family. They can start from seeds or by joining two plants together by grafting.

> It can take 8-10 years for an apple tree to mature from seed to produce fruit.

Apples are handpicked. The fruit furthest from the trunk ripens first.
